EUROPEAN COLLEGE schools

EUROPEAN COLLEGE schools focus not only on theoretical teaching, but also on the acquisition of practical skills, high level of foreign language proficiency and the employability of graduates in their future careers. Emphasis is placed on cultural traditions and educational values with a focus on high quality teaching, prioritizing the development of practical skills over mere formal achievements in qualification frameworks.

One of the long-term strategic goals of the EUROPEAN COLLEGE schools is internationalization, which plays a key role in their approach. We consider it essential to complement domestic education with international experiences.

In the 2021-2027 programme period, EUROPEAN COLLEGE schools aim to participate primarily in Key Action 1 (KA1) – Learning Mobility of Individuals. Initially, the schools plan to focus on outgoing student mobility for traineeships and outgoing staff mobility for training, as these activities align well with the schools' objective of offering students practical experience. EUROPEAN COLLEGE schools actively support student exchanges and internships abroad, both during and after studies, and assist students in securing employment opportunities abroad.

Once EUROPEAN COLLEGE schools have established a solid international network, we aim to broaden our offer to include student mobility for studies and staff mobility for teaching, available both for incoming and outgoing participants. The incoming students/staff will be welcomed not only by the employees of the college but also by the students as the buddy system is being introduced.

Our primary goal is to create an international network that will serve as a basis for future cooperation and participation in European projects. Secondary goals include creating an international environment and improving the language skills and personal development of students and staff. This international atmosphere will be enhanced by the arrival of visiting lecturers and the organization of international events. By involving students and teachers from abroad, we plan to enrich our educational environment with diverse cultural perspectives. Participation in the Erasmus+ programme will help us achieve these goals and offer students and staff valuable international experience.





The impact of the Erasmus+ Programme is expected on three levels:

1. Students: Participation will enhance language skills and personal development, offering students the unique opportunity to better understand themselves, increase self-reliance, and build self-confidence. This experience will also strengthen their academic and social skills, making them more competitive in the job market.
2. Staff: All staff members, not just teachers, will have the chance to acquire new skills. Alongside language and personal growth, professional development is anticipated. Participation in events such as international weeks and specialized courses will help expand the college's international network.
3. Institution: Involvement in Erasmus+ will align with the college's goals of internationalization and modernization. Knowledge exchange through international events, workshops, and collaborations will foster innovative practices, not only within the college but also throughout the broader educational community.

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
